Thank you to Charlotte Furneaux for keeping us pictorially up to date with how the Coronation was marked up in


Yorkshire, most specifically in the town of Knaresborough, where they really take decorative festivity to the maximum.
Like many areas countrywide there

had been a concerted effort of collaboration between local towers in order to ensure that they were all able to have their bells ringing out on Coronation Day. Charlotte herself rang at Swillington (8), Kippax (6) and Rothwell (8) that morning, with a band that consisted of 18 ringers across the three towers.
On Thursday evening on $11^{\text {th }}$ May, the Wolvercote ringers decamped for one night only to play some music
 at their sister church across a few bridges to the south, namely All Saints, Wytham. After a rather wet afternoon, the weather cleared up just in time for everyone to appreciate the exterior of this $14^{\text {th }}$ century church as it was bathed in late sunlight. The church here was rebuilt in the early $19^{\text {th }}$ century by the Bertie family, using materials from their former manor house of


Cumnor Place. The ten bells in the tower, cast by Gillett \& Johnston of Croydon, were installed in 1951 and are chimed by means of a baton keyboard, with various hymns and tunes numbered on a flip pad to give everyone a chance to participate.
